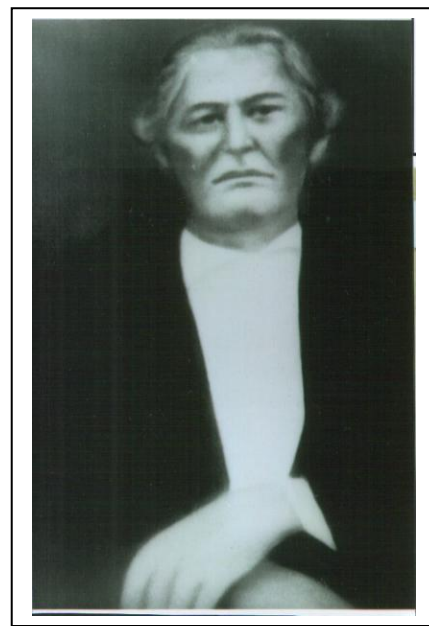

Carter County Order Book 16 at Page 314 list Rancy as being exonerated from taxes. He served as a Ky. Private in the Second U.S. Infantry. Rancie's obit in the Carter County Herald read as follows:

#### MAN COMMITS SUICIDE

Near Grayson on the head of Everman creek on Sunday evening, May 29, Mr. Yancey (sic Rancie) Forrest, past 50 years of age, tired with the ways of life, decided that he would put an end to the whole thing and cross into a strange land from whence no traveler hast as yet returned. He went to the barn, about 100 yards from the home, secured a rope and gently placed it in a solid place and tied it around his neck at one end and used the other to fasten on the barn and proceeded to jump into space, where he hung until dead. The family searched for him and near midnight the same night found him hanging dead to the rope. Coroner L. F. Tyree was called and he went to the scene and held the inquest. He was a prominent citizen and at one time was a good liver. He had been married twice and had two families.

## **William Thompson**

Old research states that William Thompson was born in Ulster, Ireland in 1722, and died on July 9, 1798 in Tazewell County, Virginia. He first settled in Pennsylvania and then to Virginia where he purchased 229 acres on the Clinch River at Morris Knob. [Recorded in Surveyor's plat book, Montgomery Co., VA]. Pendleton's History of Tazewell County, Virginia and Southwest Virginia on pages 424-426 says: "One William Thompson took up a survey of 222 acres of land in what is now Tazewell County in 1774 and later acquired a large boundary of valuable land in the present Thompson Valley and built his home about six miles south of the town of Tazewell.

He served as Lt. in Capt. Breckinridge's command during the Revolutionary War [Roster of VA DAR, p 663], later to be promoted to Captain. He was awarded 4000 acres of land for services in the American Revolution by the State of Virginia. His first wife was Jean Buchanan, and they were the parents of two children: 1] Archibald Thompson, born July 10, 1762, died August 4, 1848 in Tazewell County. He married Rebecca Peery, daughter of George Peery of Abb's Valley. 2] John Thompson, born February 27, 1764 in Augusta County, Virginia, died July 16, 1850 in Tazewell County. He also lived for a time in Montgomery County. He was twice married, his first wife being Louisa Bowen, daughter of Lt. Reece [Rees] Bowen who was killed at the Battle of King's Mountain. He married 2] Mary Walker by whom there was no additional children. He had at least five children by Louisa Bowen: William, who married Matilda Witten; James; Archibald, Walter, and Rees Bowen Thompson.

William Thompson was twice married. He had three more sons by his second wife, Mary Patton. One of the sons by his second wife was know as "Lawyer James Thompson" a man of ability, and was the first Commonwealth Attorney of Tazewell County, according to Pendleton's History Book.
