This Indenture made and entered into this
the 9th day of September one thousand eight
hundred and fifty between Henry a freeman of
color of the County of Moultrie an @oman-
on weath of Kentucky of the first part and
Charles Bell of the Town of Greenville County
and State aforesaid of the other part. witness
eth that the said Henry a freeman of color for
and consideration of the sum of thirty five dollars
tax paid to him in hand paid by the said Charles Bell
the receipt where of is hereby acknowledged have this
day bargained and by these presents doth grant barg-
gain sell assign and convey unto the said Bell and
his heirs forever a certain tract or parcel of land situate
lying and being ^{in the} County and State aforesaid on the
waters of Cat East Creek a branch of Pond Creek
and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at two white oaks
and a black gum Garland & Creige Conon in Britton
Willis old line running thence with Craig line

N 18 W 45 poles to 8 white oaks thence with the same
 S 25 E. 86. poles to black oak white oak and post oak thence S 60
 W. 20 poles to a white oak branch Woods corner thence with
 Moore line S. 55 East 60 poles to his corner a white oak
 thence with the same N. 14 East 58 poles to his corner
 a white corner a white oak thence N. 18 E. ~~100~~ poles to
 red oak and black gum thence N. 19 East 28 poles to
 two white oaks in a line of two hundred acre survey
 of Land Britton Willis thence with his line N. 54 W. 113 poles
 to his corner a white oak and black gum thence with
 the same N. 36 E. 38 poles to two white oaks in a line of an
 other 200 acre survey of said Willis thence with his line
 N. 50 W. 13. poles to the Beginning containing fifty five acres
 be the same more or less to have and to hold with
 all and singular the premises and appertinances therunto
 belonging or in any wise appertaining to him the
 said Bell his heirs and assigns forever free from
 the claim of him the said Henry a free man of color
 his heirs and also free from the claim of all & every
 other persons or persons whatsoever will forever warrant
 and defend the title of the same ^{unto} the said Bell and
 his heirs forever infirmable. In testimony whereof the said
