

This Deed, made and entered into this 25th day of October 1883, by and between Vega B Morton party of the first part and the Central Coal & Iron Company parties of the second part. Witnesseth, that the part- of the first part, for and in consideration of the deeding to Vega B Morton in deed of same date lots No 2-3-6-7-10-11-14-15-18-21-22-24-25-28-30-32-34-37-38-41-42-45-46-49 & 50 twenty five lots in the subdivision of the Muir & Morton property as per plat filed in Muhlenberg County Court. Concurrent date with this, has bargained and sold, and by these presents does bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, its heirs and assigns forever, the following described lot or parcel of land, lying and being in the County of Muhlenberg and State of Kentucky to wit, an undivided one half of ten and one half acres of ground bought of L W Kincheloe by S Muir and Thos R Morton lying in Muhlenberg County Ky. on the waters of Cypress Creek in the Town of Central City Ky.
