make and give forth and declare this to be my last will and
testament - that is to say -

Real and personal I give bequeath and dispose of as follows to wit;

one hundred dollars and a horse and saddle and one mitch
Cow and one Beed and I do hereby give to my eldest daughter
Caroline McRoy - one dollar more - And to my eldest son
Essex P. Miller one hundred dollars and a horse & a good saddle & a
mitch Cow & a Beed - and to my second son P. Miller one
one hundred dollars & a horse & a good saddle & one mitch Cow, & a
Beed and to my second daughter Marcan Miller one hundred
dollars & a horse & a good saddle & a mitch Cow, & a Beed, and the
remainder of my estate both persona or real I do hereby give to my
beloved wife Martha Miller to hold and to keep for her natural life
or her widowhood - and at her death or marriage the remaining
portion of my estate both personal & real is to go to my three youngest
Children Essex P. Miller P. Miller & to Marcan Miller
equally divided a between the three - and lastly of all I do
hereby appoint my beloved wife Martha Miller my Exe-
cutor over my Will & Testament -
