13 May 1885, Wednesday [p.17]

Allen Sloan, aged 80, of Rock House Bottom, father of Steven Sloan, died last week.

19 May 1886, Wednesday [p.18]

James R. McBeath died 12 May at the age of 59. Though born in Russell County, he had lived in Adair for many years. He is survived by a wife and three grown daughters.

1 December 1886, Wednesday [p.18]

Capt. A.C. Wells, County Clerk of Russell County, committed suicide at the courthouse last Wednesday.

25 October 1887, Tuesday [p.19]

Cleve Hayse, an old citizen of Russell County, died on 6 October.

25 March 1890, Tuesday [p.20]

Miss Dellie Cl. Hays died 1 February 1890, aged 21 years and two days. She died at her home on Crocus Creek in Russell County.

29 April 1892, Friday [p.21]

John E. Grider died on 22 April 1892. He was over 80 years of age. (Creelsboro letter)

12 July 1894, Thursday [p.22]

Samuel Denny, a Mexican War veteran, died at his home on Sand Lick, Russell County, recently.

27 September 1894, Thursday [22]

The wife of Thomas Holt, of color, of Crocus, died on the 16<sup>th</sup>.

13 February 1896, Thursday [p.23]

Mrs. James McKinney, of near Jamestown, died Sunday at the of 87. Mr. McKinney is aged 92.

James Wolford, a half-brother of General Frank Wolford, who lived near Jamestown, died Saturday.

Jos. McElroy was murdered in Russell Springs last Saturday.

1 January 1898 [p.24]

Frank Sullivan, aged 27 years, of near Crocus, died in a housefire recently.

15 October 1898, Saturday [p.24]

Clayton Snow, of near Creelsboro, died on the 7<sup>th</sup>. His wife survives.
